The Corporation of the Town of Marathon Pandemic Planning COVID-19 Update – Carden Cove Road Opening

MARATHON, ON; May 4, 2020 – The Town of Marathon remains diligent in monitoring the situation as it pertains to COVID-19. We continue to evaluate all Public Health Agency communications as well as communications from other Federal and Provincial Government Health Authorities. The health and well-being of our residents is of great importance.

The Emergency Control Group met today and has made the decision to open Carden Cove Road to public traffic on May 6th. The washroom, tables, and benches will be closed for public use. Walking through, but not congregating at, the beach area to access to local trails is permissible.

"This creates another area and opportunity for our residents to get outdoors with spring now upon us. We ask the public to respect the closed off areas and continue to maintain social distancing and adhering to all measures in place to protect health and safety." Mayor Rick Dumas.
