## The Corporation of the Town of Marathon Pandemic Planning COVID-19 Update – Additional Municipal Facility Closures

**MARATHON, ON; December 7, 2020 –** The Town of Marathon remains diligent in monitoring the situation as it pertains to COVID-19. We continue to evaluate all Public Health Agency communications as well as communications from other Federal and Provincial Government Health Authorities. The health and well-being of our residents is of great importance.

The Emergency Control Group (ECG) met over the course of the last two days and effective immediately:

- The Marathon Arena, Port Hole Pool, and Lakeview Community Hall will be closed until December 19 at which time the situation will be re-evaluated.
- Town Hall will be closed to the public until December 21.

"With the advancing COVID situation in our community, we need to limit the amount of people interactions in the community at this time as well as protect our essential municipal staff. Therefore, closing our municipal facilities as a temporary measure is another safeguard we can put in place at this time." Mayor Rick Dumas.
