COVID-19 Update – Municipal Recreation Facilities Re-openings

MARATHON, ON; January 27, 2022 – The Town of Marathon remains diligent in monitoring the situation as it pertains to COVID-19. We continue to evaluate all Public Health Agency communications as well as communications from other Federal and Provincial Government Health Authorities. The health and well-being of our residents is of great importance.

The Emergency Control Group has met, and based on Ontario's updated public health measures, the following COVID-19 protocols will be effective January 31, 2022, at municipal facilities that are re-opening:

- The Marathon Arena will re-open for regular use and programming and have a capacity limit of 320 users:
- Port Hole Pool will re-open for programming and usage and have a capacity of 62 users;
- Lakeview Community Hall will re-open for programming and rentals and have a capacity of 88 users:
- Marathon X-Country Ski Chalet will have a capacity limit of 50 users;
- Marathon Seniors Clubhouse will have a capacity limit of 19 users;
- Marathon Bowling Lanes will have a capacity limit of 36 users; and
- Active proof of vaccine screening via a valid QR code, physical distancing, mask wearing, and hand hygiene remain in place at all municipal facilities.

"The winter season can be long so it is great that we can get back into our recreation facilities and be active; especially for our youth. I once again encourage our residents to get vaccinated and their booster shot so we can continue to move our community towards even safer and higher vaccination rates." States Mayor Rick Dumas.
