The Corporation of the Town of Marathon Pandemic Planning Suspension of Municipal Fire Permits and Open Burning

MARATHON, ON; March 27, 2020 – The Town of Marathon remains diligent in monitoring the situation as it pertains to COVID-19. We continue to evaluate all Public Health Agency communications as well as communications from other Federal and Provincial Government Health Authorities. The health and well-being of our residents is of great importance.

The protection and health of our front line Firefighters during this COVID-19 situation is a priority. Ensuring we have adequate Firefighters to respond to emergency calls is critical to the safety of the municipality and its residents. Therefore effective immediately, all municipally-issued fire permits and any open burning within the municipality is suspended until further notice.

A full refund will be issued for those residents that have purchased a 2020 fire permit if they desire.
